FOR OPENERS

- The Cavaliers are set to meet Maryland Eastern Shore at John Paul Jones Arena on Sunday (Nov. 30) at 2 p.m. ET on ACC Network Extra (ACCNX).
- · Head coach Amaka Agugua-Hamilton is 33-10 against non-conference opposition in her four seasons at the helm at UVA.
- · Virginia is averaging 77.7 points per game and limiting opposition to 52.5 ppg.
- · The Cavaliers rank No. 20 in NCAA Division I in scoring defense and No. 29 in scoring margin (25.7).
- · Virginia is in its 53rd season of women's basketball sporting a 998-565 (.638) record.

SERIES HISTORY

- The Cavaliers meet UMES for just the fifth time in program
- · All four of the previous matchups have taken place in Charlottesville.
- Virginia owns a +21.25 margin of victory against Maryland Fastern Shore

LAST TIME AGAINST THE HAWKS

- · The two teams met last season at JPJ, an 80-64 win for Virginia.
- · Kymora Johnson led all players with 24 points to go with nine rebounds and six assists.
- · Latasha Lattimore pitched in 18 points and pulled down 15 rebounds.
- · Four Cavaliers scored in double figures: Johnson (24), Lattimore (18), Olivia McGhee (14), Breona Hurd (11)
- · Virginia outrebounded UMES 40-24. The Cavaliers also dished out 10 assists as a team.
- The Cavalier bench accounted for 33 points.

PRESEASON HONORS

- · Virginia's Kymora Johnson and Sa'Myah Smith picked up preseason honors at the conference and national level.
- · Johnson was named to the Wooden Award Watchlist, Naismith Player of the Year Trophy Preseason Watch List, the Nancy Lieberman Preseason Watch List and a first-team All-ACC Selection. She was also ranked No. 15 on ESPN's preseason top-25 players in women's college basketball.
- · Smith was named to the Katrina McClain Award Preseason Watch List, which honors the nation's best power forward.

ON THE HORIZON

- Virginia will travel to Vanderbilt for the third annual ACC/ SEC Challenge on Wednesday, Dec. 3.
- · The game will air on SEC Network (SECN)
- · Fans can also tune in live on WINA (98.9FM/1070AM).

LAST TIME OUT

- The Cavaliers fell to Nebraska by a score of 91-82 in the Beach Bracket Championship at the Emerald Coast Classic.
- Virginia trailed by as many as 19 points in the third quarter, but rallied to pull within four points with less than four minutes to play in the game.
- The Cavaliers tied a program record shooting 80-percent (8-for-10) from the floor and went 5-for-7 from long range in the fourth quarter to cut the deficit to two possessions with as few as 16 seconds left on the clock.
- · Tournament MVP Britt Prince led the Cornhuskers with a tournament record 30 points while Amiah Hargrove netted 17 points and pulled down eight rebounds.
- · Kymora Johnson led the Cavaliers with 24 points six rebounds and six assists while netting 15 of her points in the fourth quarter.
- · Paris Clark was named to the Emerald Coast Classic Beach Bracket All-Tournament Team.

- coach on March 21, 2022. Native of Herndon, Va., where she attended Oakton HS.
- Tripled the Cavaliers' win total (15) in 2022-23 from the previous two seasons combined.
- Recruited in the nation's No. 13 signing class of 2023.
- Led UVA to its first top-25 ranking in the USA Today Coaches Poll since 2010.
- Spent three seasons at Missouri State where she led the Lady Bears to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2021.
- Two-time MVC Coach of the Year (2020-21).
- 2020 WBCA Rookie Coach of the Year.
- 2021 WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist.
- Recorded nine wins over Power-5 teams in three seasons at MSII
- First African-American woman to be named head coach for any sport at MSU.

LEVY'S TRIPLE DOUBLE

- · Romi Levy recorded her first triple double (14 pts, 12 reb, 10 ast) against Longwood (11/20)
- · Levy's 10 assists marked a career-high
- · She joined Dawn Stalev and Kymora Johnson as the only Cavaliers to accomplish the feat in program history.
- · The previous triple double by a Cavalier was Johnson's at Pitt 2/16/25 (20pts, 11reb, 11 ast). Staley accomplished the feat twice in 1991.
- · Levy becomes just the fifth Cavalier between both the UVA men's and women's programs to record a triple-double. That list is made up of Levy, Dawn Staley, Ralph Sampson, Kymora Johnson, and Bill Miller.
- · Lewy's is one of just 4 triple doubles Division I this season

CRASH THE GLASS

- The Cavaliers are second in NCAA Division I in rebounding margin with a mark of 18.6.
- · Virginia ranks eighth in the nation with 18.3 offensive rebounds per game

CULTURE WINS

- · Since becoming UVA's sixth head coach in the spring of 2022, one of Amaka "Mox" Agugua-Hamilton's biggest points of emphasis has been establishing a strong culture now and for years to come.
- · A few of Virginia's team mantras include: "Grind Now, Shine Later(#GNSL), Culture Wins, Family, and Give.
- · Coach Mox has defined her mantra "Grind Now, Shine Later" as 'progress is a process'. When you focus on the work that's in front of you, the results and recognition will fall into place.

CHARLOTTESVILLE'S HOT TICKET

- The Cavaliers have broken the program's record for season tickets sold in both 2024 and 2025. They are expected to break that record once again in 2026.
- · On March 3, 2024, UVA hosted 11,975 spectators on Senior Day for a 80-75 win over No. 5 Virginia Tech. The game set a record attendance figure for any women's basketball game in the state of Virginia.
- UVA was fifth in the ACC in attendance in 2025, the only season with higher attendance figures in program history was in 1991-92 when the team was coming off its first national championship appearance.

DROPPING DIMES

- · Kymora Johnson ranks No. 28 in NCAA Divison I and No. 3 in the ACC with 5.8 assists per game.
- · She has registered at least five assists in four of UVA's five games this season
- · She recorded a season-high eight assists against Radford.

JOHNSON STARTS HOT IN SEASON OPENER

- · Kymora Johnson netted 19 first-half points on her way to a 24-point performance in a season-opening win over Morgan State.
- · Romi Levy was two points away from a double-double (8 pts, 11 reb) in her Cavalier debut.
- · Levy's eight points were exactly enough to reach 1,000 for her career.
- · Paris Clark went for 18 points in UVA's season opener, just one point shy of a career-high.

GAME NOTES

- · Virginia was selected seventh in the 2025-26 ACC preseason poll
- · The selection marks UVA's highest position in the poll since 2017 when it was picked sixth.
- · Duke was picked as the preseason favorite followed by NC State, North Carolina, Louisville, Notre Dame and Stanford.

THE RETURNERS

- This season, Virginia returns five players from last year's squad including first team All-ACC Selection and WBCA All-America Honorable Mention Kymora Johnson.
- · The Cavaliers also return Paris Clark, Olivia McGhee, Breona Hurd and Jillian Brown.

NEW FACES

- UVA inked seven players from the transfer portal this offseason including five bigs: Sa'Myah Smith (LSU), Tabitha Amanze (Princeton), Adeang Ring (UCF), Caitlin Weimar (NC State), and Dannelle Arigbabu (West Virginia).
- · Virginia also landed a pair of guards in Raiane Dias Dos Santos (FSU), and Romi Levy (USF).
- · Virginia signed four-star freshman guard Gabby White who ranked No. 96 in the ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 recruiting

2024-25 SEASON IN REVIEW

- At 17-15, Virginia recorded its first winning record since the 2017-18 season, its eight ACC wins mark the highest total since the 2019-20 season.
- · The Cavaliers concluded 2024-25 by winning five of their last seven contests, including a win at No. 8 North Carolina, the program's first victory in Chapel Hill since 2001.
- · Virginia set a program record for season ticket sales for the second consecutive season in 2024-25. UVA was fifth in the ACC in attendance in 2025, the only season with higher attendance figures in program history was in 1991-92 when the team was coming off its first national championship appearance.
- · Seven of Virginia's 15 losses were by two possessions or

THE 2025-26 SCHEDULE

- · UVA's full season schedule features 28 unique opponents, 10 of which made NCAA Tournament play in 2024-25 and combined for a total of 11 wins in the tournament.
- · Eight of Virginia's opponents earned an eight-seed or higher in the 2024-25 tournament.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- · Under head coach Amaka Agugua-Hamilton, UVA is 31-9 against non-ACC teams.
- · The Cavaliers won their first 14 match ups against non-conference foes before falling to No. 25 Oklahoma, 82-67, on Nov. 19.

JOHNSON IN ELITE COMPANY

The 2024-25 season featured impressive milestones for

Kymora Johnson

- Kymora Johnson entered an exclusive club, recording just the third-ever triple double in program history in an 80-67 win over Pitt (Feb. 16) and the first at UVA since 1991.
- Johnson totaled 20 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 11 assists in the performance.
- · Johnson is one of just two Cavaliers in the history of the program to record a triple double.
- Dawn Staley first accomplished the feat against NC State (24 pts, 10 reb, 11 ast; 1/12/91) and did it again just over a month later once again against NC State (23 pts, 11 reb, 10 ast; 2/23/91).
- · Across both men's and women's programs at UVA, Johnson becomes the fourth Cavalier to accomplish the feat, joining the likes of Staley, Ralph Sampson and Bill Miller.

<u> JOHNSON JOINS 1K CLUB</u>

- Kymora Johnson became the 37th Cavalier to join the 1,000 point club after scoring 33 points in an 89-69 win over Stanford (Feb. 23).
- The last Cavalier to reach the milestone was Dominique Toussaint who became the 36th member of the club in the 2018-19 season.
- The last player to join the club in her sophomore season was Jocelyn Willoughby in the 2018-19 season. Willoughby ranks No. 9 on the career scoring list with 1,677 points.

CLIMBING THE ASSIST RANKINGS

- · As a freshman in 2023-24, Kymora Johnson set the Viginia freshman record for assists with 183.
- · That freshman total ranks as the seventh highest singleseason total in program history.
- She followed her freshman season with another top-10 season with 185 assists as a sophomore in 2025.

WINS OVER RANKED OPPONENTS

- · Virginia went 1-6 against ranked opposition in 2025
- In 2024, the Cavaliers recorded four wins over ranked opponents (at #15 Florida State, vs. #20 North Carolina, at #20 Louisville and #5 Virginia Tech) for the first time since the 2008-09 season,
- Prior to Virginia naming Amaka Agugua-Hamilton head coach on March 21, 2022, the Cavaliers had lost 27 consecutive match ups to ranked opponents.
- Entering its match up against FSU, the Cavaliers were 3-47 in their last 50 games against ranked opponents.
- The win over the fifth-ranked Hokies marked UVA's first over an AP top-5 foe since knocking off No. 4 Florida State on Feb. 16. 2017.
